FINAL REGISTRATION & WELCOME KIT DELIVER

Will be done at Orlando Kart Center, starting Thursday prior each event between 9am and 5pm at the RWT registration/information area.

ADMITTED EQUIPMENT

Regulated Chasis. Rented or owned engines by driver or drivers team, sold exclusively by Canadian or USA Distributor to be used on those territories with USA & Canadian Official Service Center seal. Tyres, fuel and oil provided by organizer. Transponders available for rent. Drivers that own their own transponder will be able to use it freely.

ENGINES IGNITION: It's absolutely **prohibited** to start engines on pits, pits space or pre grid. Engines will only be able to be turned on after fuel is ok and **ONLY ON PRE GRID AREA FOR A MAXIMUM OF 05 SECONDS ONLY**. If anybody does not comply with this regulation, Race Director will have authority on the subject.







SCALE / WEIGTHING PROCEDURE

The scale of the day will be at the end of PIT SPACE. This scale is the ONLY one which will be officially used and counted. The scale will be available from the first non-qualifying session.

Driver needs to stand on the middle of the scale with all his/her racing equipment.

Drinking water from a clear plastic bottle is allowed in the servicing park before the scale (one bottle per driver), however any driver pouring water over his/her head and race overall will be penalized with - 2 Pounds.

TECH VERIFICATION

The Tech Directors designated by the race promoter will be the only one in charge of this verification after Qualy, Heats 1 and 2 and Final Race. From qualy to Final Race, the tech team will decide which controls to do on each session. First 3 of Final Race will have a complete engine revision.

SLICK TYRES – MOJO TIRES

2 set of tires mandatory to be used on each weekend (from Qualy to Final Race).

MICRO & MINI MAX: 8 front D2 tires

JUNIOR MAX: 2 sets of D2 tires

SENIOR & UP: 2 sets of D5 tires

Those 8 tires can be used as team/driver wants in between Qualy, Heats and Final Race of each weekend

RAIN TYRES

Only LEVANTO rain tires Will be admited to use (new or used)

<u>FUEL</u>

The 5 gallons of fuel plus the 1 litre of XPS Oil for official activity (qualy, heats and final races) will be provided by the organizer. The fuel to be used is SUNOCO 90, mixed on a 2% basis with XPS OIL. Fuel and oil will be sold on the track

PRE TECH.

It is mandatory, when going on Grid on Friday Practice Session 2, that all drivers deliver the PRETECH FORM (included on Welcome Kit), completed thoroughly, to PRE GRID Staff

Also, PRETECH check is mandatory for all drivers during Friday sessions, after completing practice Session number 3 (verification on tech área).

COMPLAINTS (both Tech and Sporting)

In order to make an official complaint (techinchal or sporting) the driver will have to complete a COMPLAINTS DOCUMENT (at registration) and pay U\$S 500. Once the complaint is resolved, if the driver was correct, the money will be refunded at 100%.

Complaints Will be accepted for 30 minutes once penalty is announced.

CHASIS

Only 1 chassis can be used on each Round. In case of irreversible damage, after being authorized by the tech director, the chassis can be changed.

PRACTICE & WARM UP SESSIONS

During unofficial practices and warm up each driver will be able to choose wich tyres to use (new or used) with the only condition that they are MOJO TIRES provided by the allowed teams/tracks

PUSHBACK FRONT BUMPERS

Official CIK FIA Pushback Front Bumpers must be used from Qualy onwards in every class.

On Qualy, in case of 1 or 2 pushback bumpers hit, the best lap will be deleted. On Heats and Final Race, in case of 1 or 2 pushback bumpers hit, +5 seconds of penalty will be assigned to that driver.

The intention of the driver to reverse pushback bumpers at any time can result in an elimination from the event.

STICKERS

2 ROTAX WINTER TROPHY stickers are provided in the Welcome kit, they are mandatory to be placed on the front bumper. No other tickets regarding series, engines, tires or oils form others than ROTAX and ROTAX PARTNERS.

CLASS NUMBERS

The following numbers will be used for each class MICRO MAX - 01 to 099 MINI MAX - 100 to 199 JUNIOR MAX – 200 to 299 SENIOR MAX – 300 to 399 DD2 MAX - 400 to 499 MASTER MAX – 600 to 699 DD2 MASTER MAX - 700 to 799

The number of each driver is set automatically by registration order. The 4 numbers mandatory to be used during the events will be provided by the organization, given together with Welcome Kit









RACE SYSTEM AND GENERAL SCHEDULE

2 Events, 4 Rounds, EACH ROUND HAS THE SAME GENERAL SCHEDULE (both Saturday & Sunday)

For Senior Max, qualy session groups are determined by Kart Number (Group A karts 300 to 320, Group B 321 to 341, Group C 342 and over)

The result of qualy will determine the grid order for each of the HEATS

For the Qualifying Heats, points Will be awarded as follows:

1st 50, 2nd 33, 3rd 41, 4th 38, 5th 36, 6th 34, 7th 31, 8th 30, 9th 28, 10th 27, 11th 26, 12th 25, 13th 24, 14th 23, 15th 22, 16th 21, 17th 20, 18th 19, 19th 18, 20th 17, 21st 16, 22nd 15, 23rd 14, 24th 13, 25th 12, 26th 11, 27th 10, 28th 9, 29th 8, 30th 7, 31st 6, 32nd 5, 33rd 4, 34th 3, 35th 2, 36th 1.

If a driver does not take the start at a Qualifying Heat, he/she Will receive points equal to the number of points of the last qualified driver minus 1 point.

If a driver has been black-flagged or disqualified, he/she Will receive points equal to the number of points of the last qualified driver minus 5 points.

Any driver who has not covered all the laps scheduled, even if he/she has not finished a Qualifying Heat, Will be classified according to the number of laps he/she has actually completed.

At the end of Qualifying Heats, an intermediate classification Will be established. Possible ties between two or more drivers Will be settles according to their classification in the Qualy

ENGINE CHANGE

If an engine is changed, from Qualy onwards, that driver will have 10 positions penalty in the Final Race of that round. In the next round the driver will race normally. Also, if engine is changed, driver or mech MUST advise to Tech Director







CHAMPIONSHIP POINTING SYSTEM

At every Qualifying Heats and Final Races, points for Championship Standings will be awarded to drivers.

POLE POSITION AWARDS 1 extra POINT (per weekend)

All races will distribute the same amount of points except ROUND 3 (Saturday February 3rd) that will allow 50% PLUS on each point awarded (qualy, heats and final race)

Each individual Round awards these points. The driver with more points by the end of 4 rounds will be 2024 WINTER TROPHY CHAMPION. If a tie is persisted, the driver who won more FINAL RACES will be the champion. If ties continues, the driver who got more 2nd places on Final Races, if it stills persist, the driver that qualified the best on Round 1.

To receive points the driver must complete at least 75% of each Heat/Final Race. If this does not happen, no matter the reason why, points will not be awarded to that driver.







PRIZES AND AWARDS

The Champion of the ROTAX WINTER TROPHY of each class will have this prize:

<u>MICRO MAX</u> – Micro Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket <u>MINI MAX</u> – Mini Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket <u>JUNIOR MAX</u> – Junior Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket <u>SENIOR MAX</u> – Senior Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket <u>DD2 MAX</u> – DD2 Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket <u>MASTER MAX</u> – DD2 Master Max 2024 Grand Finals Ticket (+32 years)

To be crowned the Champion, the driver must have raced the 4 rounds and have the greatest number of points once they are finished.

AGES & DETAILS REQUIRED TO COMPETE AT RMC GRAND FINALS.

MICRO MAX: Drivers must have his/her 8th birthday during the year of the event and must have his/her 12th birthday after the year of the event. Must hold a valid National Karting License and a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN

MINI MAX: Drivers must have his/her 10th birthday during the year of the event and must have his/her 14th birthday after the year of the event. Must hold a valid National Karting License and a Starting Permission issued by the responsible ASN


JUNIOR MAX: Drivers must have his/her 12th birthday during the year of the event and cannot have his/her 15th birthday during the year of the event. If this happens, driver must present International Grade G License in order to compete at 2024 RWT. Must hold an International Karting License Grade G issued by ASN, an International Entrant License is required. *If a driver is 14 years old during the year of the event, he/she must hold a valid International karting license grade F according to CIK/FIA International driver license for karting drivers and code of driving conduct, article 3.4.2.

SENIOR MAX: Drivers must have his/her 14th birthday during the year of the event. Must hold an International Karting License Grade F or E issued by ASN, an International Entrant License is required.

DD2 MAX: Drivers must have his/her 15th birthday during the year of the event. Must hold an International Karting License Grade F or E issued by ASN, an International Entrant License is required.

DD2 MASTER MAX: Drivers must have his/her 32th birthday during the year of the event.







DRIVERS ON BOARD CAMERA LOCATION

NO CAMERAS Will be allowed on from QUALYFING on. This is considering fairness to every driver on track and to make equal conditions to everyone

MICRO & MINI MAX EXHAUST SEALS

Micro & Mini exhausts will be sealed mandatory on TECH área by our TECH STAFF by the end of PRACTICE 3. If anybody believes exhaust is not in conditions, please verify on PRE TECH control during practice sessions. Sealed exhaust are mandatory to be used during complete event.

DRIVERS BRIEFING (MANDATORY)

Each class Will have a mandatory drivers briefing. This briefing Will be done at ROTAX REGISTRATION AREA.

Drivers Briefing Schedules are: MICRO & MINI MAX – 10.27 AM JUNIOR MAX – 10.05 AM SENIOR MAX – 10.49 MASTERS & DD2's – 11.11AM

DRIVERS CODE OF CONDUCT OFF RACETRACK

In order to be awarded Grand Finals Ticket, drivers must not only comply the code of conduct on track but also will have to comply this during all the time in between the event and Grand Finals, so organization, distributor and BRP ROTAX can approve the ticket won

PITLANE RULES

Pits are working on a CLOSED system, no karts allowed to drive thru pits. The Kart goes up the kartstand threw the PIT ENTRANCE, and once session is over they get up their kartstands after scale to go out of pits.

On official days, ONLY Drivers Mechanic and Team Chief will be allowed to go INSIDE pitlane. Wristbands allowed will be signaled on PIT ENTRANCE.







CODE OF CONDUCT FOR DRIVERS

All participants must play within the rules and respect race officials and their decisions.

All participants must respect the rights, dignity and value of their fellow participants regardless of gender, ability, physical appearance, cultural background or religion.

All participants must encourage and take responsibility for their actions at all times.

All participants must ensure their equipment is safe and race worthy, prior to taking part in training, testing or race competitions. Only approved racewear (e.g.: helmet, gloves, race boots and suit) to be used by the driver, according to the regulations.

It is the participants own responsibility to identify and measure his/her own skill level against his/her competitors, and take responsibility for the risks associated with training, testing and or racing. It should be noted that a basic level of competence is required.

It is the participant's responsibility to declare, prior to any participation in training, testing or racing, of any medical condition or medication required that may be relevant in the event of an emergency.

All participants are required to display courtesy and etiquette to other members and participants in training, testing and race events. Any disputes or problems that may arise during a competition must be addressed in a respectful manner, to the correct person (official) at the competition.







The safety of children within the sport is a priority. Knowledge of the code of ethics surrounding care of children in sports will be promoted and encouraged. It is the participant's own responsibility to ensure the safety of children at training, testing or racing competitions.

When taking part in any competition, it is the responsibility of the driver to take the time to read and fully understand the posted rules, regulations and conditions for said competition prior to start time, thus eliminating unnecessary delays at the beginning of the competition. Requests for clarification of these rules, regulations or conditions, should be asked in the drivers meeting held before each competition.

All participants must have respect for the environment and the surrounding inhabitants. Responsibility must be taken to reduce excessive noise and keep all areas that are used as clean and pollution free as possible.

All participants must respect that drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited at training, testing and races. It is an offence and will not be tolerated. Offenders will be excluded from the competition and face further disciplinary action. Any abusive comments on social media (Facebook, Twitter etc.) between teams, competitors, officials, organizers, or any person associated with ROTAX, will be held responsible and liable for their actions.
